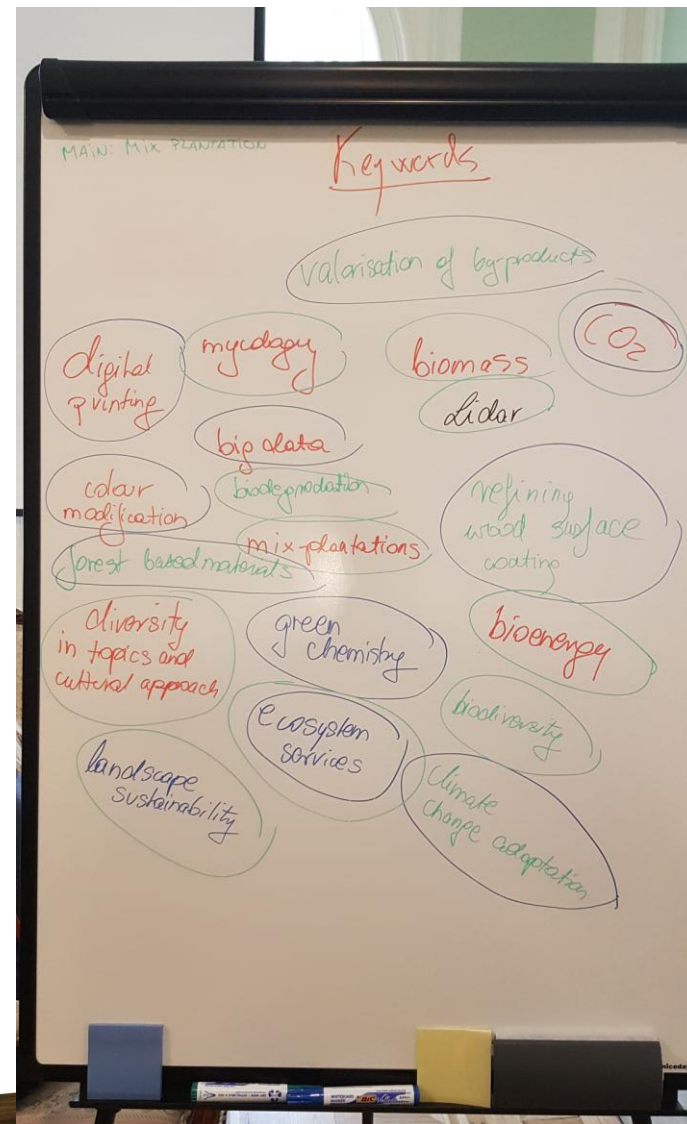

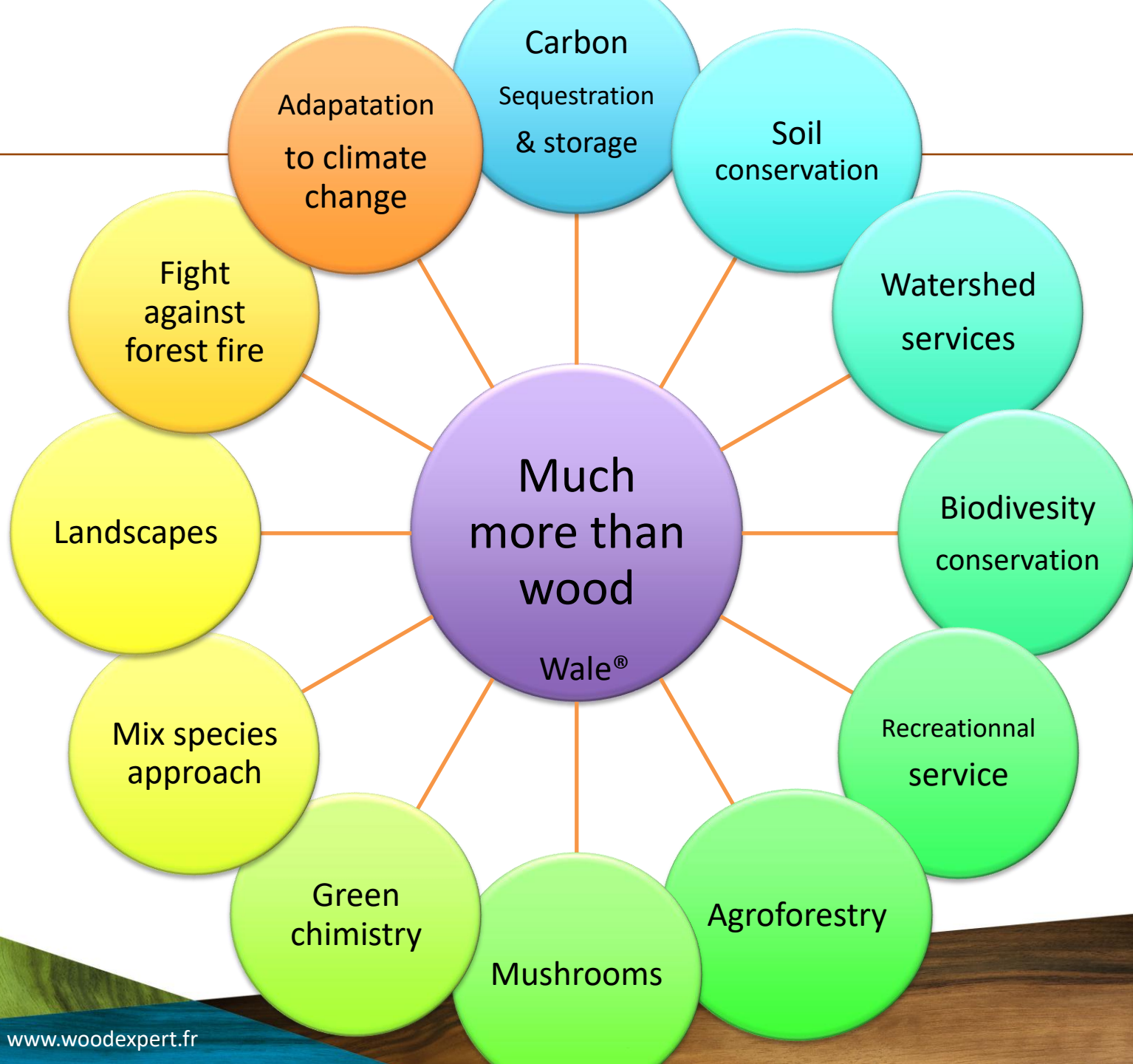

- Creating new opportunities with Polish Universities

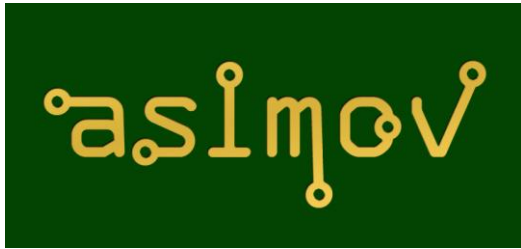
